### SPONSOR RESPONSIBILITY (THE LEAGUE)

1. PROMOTION: Each horse show will be named in all advertising listing the sanctioned events and the League Finals.
2. STANDINGS: The standings in each division will be updated and the results published.
3. MAILING: The League will provide access to an up-dated mailing list of League Members upon request.

### SHOW RESPONSIBILITY (HORSE SHOW)

1. DUES/RESULTS/REGISTRATION: The Horse Show will furnish to the League Office within **ten (10)** days of the conclusion of the event the following:
  - A. DUES: ***Show Dues has been waived for all shows for the 2025 Season.***
  - B. RESULTS: 1) Complete results including Horse, Owner, Rider, and Prize Money Won, where applicable. 2) Results must also provide Owner and Rider addresses. 3) When classes are combined, results must indicate which section points are to be awarded. 4) If a show is canceled, please inform The League of the name and show date. 5) Results not received within 20 days of the conclusion of the show will be considered to have been canceled.
  - C. MEMBERSHIP: Completed League rider membership forms and membership fees must accompany results.
2. SPECIFICATIONS: League Specifications must be posted at the Show Office for exhibitors. The Event must follow the rules and regulations as set forth in the Specifications.
3. PROGRAM/PRIZE LIST: The League requires two (2) full-page black & white advertisements in the horse show prize list and/or program:
  - A. The League Advertisement (REQUIRED) – Available online at: [HITSShows.com](http://HITSShows.com)
  - B. Marshall & Sterling Insurance Advertisement (REQUIRED) – Available online at: [HITSShows.com](http://HITSShows.com)
4. LEAGUE PROMOTION:
  - A. Member Shows will make available to exhibitors the current membership forms, specifications, and other promotional materials supplied to the horse show by the League.
  - B. Member Shows will display promotional materials supplied by the League.
  - C. Member Shows will provide the League with public announcements during each day of the event.
5. AWARDS PRESENTATION: The League will have the opportunity to make the official presentations to the winning riders.
6. SAFESPORT COMPLIANCE: Member-shows must complete and sign the compliance portion of this agreement listing the names, dates and USEF #s (if applicable) of all shows hosting League classes. ***There is no substitution or exception to this portion of the agreement.***

**SafeSport Compliance Agreement  
Between “The League Presented by Marshall & Sterling Insurance” and Host Member-Show**

This Agreement dated \_\_\_\_\_, between “The League Presented by Marshall & Sterling Insurance” (“The League”) and \_\_\_\_\_, as Manager and responsible party for the Host Member League shows listed below sets forth the terms and conditions under which each The League member show agrees to follow and implement USEF’s SafeSport Ban and Prohibition Lists.

Still in affect for the 2025 season is The League’s newly adopted SafeSport compliance policy for its individual members and show members in support of the equestrian community’s SafeSport initiative and in the interest of protecting The League’s members, and especially minors, from harm and abuse.

If your show is a USEF member show, you are already implementing SafeSport policy. If you are a non-USEF show, it will be easiest to administer the new policy if you use an electronic horse show system for entries. In any case, The League’s staff will help you implement the SafeSport requirements listed below.

The League member show agrees to comply with the following:

1. Prohibit participation in the show by anyone on the U.S. Center for SafeSport, USEF, or FEI suspension or banned lists. Such individuals must be prohibited from entry on the grounds and made to leave if they enter, except individuals on the medical suspension list who may be present on the grounds but prohibited from participating. This includes any competition from which HITS recognizes results for purposes of point accumulation or qualification for the League, or any competition that HITS associates with The League in any way.
2. Conduct The League qualification classes in accordance with the League Rules. Submit all League competition results and list of competitors to HITS.
3. USEF Affiliation. The League member show agrees to refrain from affiliating with or becoming recognized by any national organization for the breeds and disciplines that USEF governs, other than the ones recognized by USEF as Recognized Affiliates, unless an agreement with USEF is reached concerning the scope of said affiliation.

By signing below, the member League show agrees to the above terms and conditions and confirms that the entity signing on behalf of the show is legally authorized to bind the show.
