

In accordance with GR 1111.4: Contiguous states are: AR, KY, LA, MO, NC, VA. **JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS**: To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count. Horses and ponies are not required to jog for soundness.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER AND ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER SECTIONS

To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER: Riders may cross enter between the Adult Amateur Hunter and Adult Amateur Owner section if the rider owns the horse he or she is showing in the Adult Amateur section. Horses: may not cross enter between the Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same show. Horse-and-rider combination is not eligible for any other USEF rated classes in which fence height exceeds 3'0" (Exception: Equitation 3'3", USHJA National Hunter Derby). Fence heights: 1.0m Amateur Jumper: 1.00m-1.05m; 1.10m Amatuer Jumper: 1.10m-1.15m. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may also be combined with Junior Jumper if so stated in the prize list. Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to 1.0m Amateur Jumper and 1.10m Amateur Jumper sections.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER AND CHILDREN'S JUMPER SECTIONS

To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current competition year.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE 14 & Under and 15-17: Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3" (Exception: Equitation, Children's Jumpers, Pony Jumpers and the USHJA National Hunter Derby). Fence Height: 3'0" spreads not to exceed fence height. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies. Combinations will be permitted. Children's Hunter Horse sections may be combined if there are fewer than six entries in a section. If there are six or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter Horse may be combined if there are fewer than three entries in either section. Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under and Children's Hunter Horse 15-17 sections.

LOW CHILDREN'S JUMPER AND HIGH CHILDREN'S JUMPER: Any competitor that competes in any class set at over 1.25m is ineligible to compete in a Junior Jumper class set below 1.20m at that competition. 1.0m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show. 1.0m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both 1.0m and 1.10m are offered. 1.10m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations are not permitted to cross enter into Junior Jumper classes or any class at 1.20m and above that offers prize money, at the same competition. 1.10m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both 1.0m and 1.10m are offered. Fence heights: 1.0m Junior Jumper: 1.00m-1.05m; 1.10m Junior Jumpers: 1.10m-1.15m. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may also be combined with Amateur if so stated in the prize list. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. USEF Statement: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classesSafe Sport Statement: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
- 2. Federation Entry Agreement By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rule of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Post Time PremierCompetition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the Stateof New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber, I acknowledge that I will be enrolled for no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew in USEF's sole discretion. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. USEF may in its sole discretion, at any time, terminate my USEF Fan status.
- 3. Rules and conditions not covered: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.
- 4. Class and Show Conduct: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.
- 5. Hold Harmless Agreement: Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. It shall be a condition of the entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show, any affiliated organizations, the officials, employees, directors, officers, any sponsoring entities of the horse show, and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s), employee(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause, including gross negligence.
- 6. Attire: Proper attire is required in all classes, Formal attire required in all Classics. Management reserves the right to waive jackets.
- 7. Minor Exhibitors: Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted.
- 8. Online Entries and Online Ordering: Entries can be made on-line www.showmanagementsystem.com.
- 9. Adds/Scratches: The office fee allows for unlimited adds and scratches at any time for regular classes. Adds for classics must be done by 4pm the day before the class is scheduled; post entries to start first. Any scratches after the posted order has been drawn will be considered a late scratch and may be charged a scratch fee. Add/Scratches must be done on the official "Add/Scratch" Form. The show reserves the right to limit same day adds, please do your adds early!
- 10. Cords, Fans, and Electric Golf Carts: All extension cords must have a GROUNDED 3 POINT PRONG if they are to be used at the stabling area. ABSOLUTELY NO INDOOR RATED CORDS or cords with the grounding prongs removed. Management and grounds staff will CUT and remove cords that violate this rule NO EXCEPTIONS. Show or fair management will not be held liable for the cords lost. All electric must be plugged in only in designated areas, and may be subject to an additional charge. NO GOLF CARTS ARE ALLOWED IN BARNS.
- 11. Condition of Entry: All entries must be postmarked by December 20, 2024 and must be done online. Entries will be accepted after, but may be charged a Post Entry fee. All entries must be sent with a \$125 prepaid horse deposit (Facility Fee) that will be applied to horse's show account. The entry form for each horse must include: All classes (if known), all mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibiting, organization membership numbers, and Social Security or Federal ID number of prize money recipient. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entry blanks may be charged a \$50 "Incomplete Entry Fee". The horse show management has the right to decline any entry with out cause before or during the horse show without being liable for damages. Entry numbers WILL NOT be issued without: 1) All necessary health requirements as defined in the <u>Statement of Health</u> page. 2) A valid credit card or SIGNED open check lodged with the Horse Show Secretary.
- 12. Payments: Checks should be made payable to HITS, LLC credit card charges will appear as HITS. LLC on credit card statements. Checks or credit cards for deposits and Horse Stalls will be processed upon receipt.
- 13. Entries Scratched from Show: Horses scratched from the show before the closing date will receive a refund, less a \$125 Office Fee. Horses scratched after the closing date but before the start of the show will be charged the Facility Fee and all Stall Fees, if applicable. Entries Scratched after the start of the show will be billed for all the above fees plus any additional charges incurred during the show.
- 14. Prize Money: Prize Money will be applied to entries. The Payee will default to the Owner, if the Prize Money Recipient is not provided on the submitted entry. A valid Social Security or Federal ID number and complete mailing address must be provided. If the SSN/EIN has not been provided to the show office within 90 days of the competition, it will be forfeited. Net Prize Money credits will be issued as a check and will be mailed or hand-delivered within 30 days after the Show, thereby ending the show's responsibility. Exhibitors: Please verify the correct payee and mailing address is recorded in the Show Office. HITS is not responsible for checks lost or issued to incorrect payees. If the SSN/ EIN is not provided, Prize Money will be withheld until SSN / EIN is provided. If the IRS has notified us of a discrepancy in Payee name or SSN / EIN prize money will be withheld until the discrepancy is resolved. If an outstanding balance exists on an account, prize money may be withheld. If the SSN/EIN has not been provided to the show office within 90 days of the competition, it will be forfeited. Prize Money will not be reissued after 90 days. Prize Money Won by Foreign Exhibitors is subject to the U.S. Internal Revenue Service regulation requiring sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a Social Security number and will be asked to complete Form W-8BEN prior to receiving prize money. Prize Money is awarded through 6th place in hunter classes and through 8th place in jumper classes. A class that pays based on a number of entries will pay based on the number of on-time entries and post entries will not be included in the number used to determine the payout. A class with fewer than three entries will not award prize money. Prize Money Publications: In 2024 the hunter payout was l: \$13,988.50 II: \$21,806.50, the published amount was; I:39,650, II: \$41,150. For 2025 the published hunter prize money is Wk 1: \$25,750 Wk 2: \$28,050, the guaranteed hunter prize money pay out
- 15. Award Presentations: All exhibitors are required to present for award presentations, when necessary. Any exhibitors who are not present for award presentations will forfeit any prize money won during the class.
- 16. Splitting of Tack/Equipment Stalls and Other Fees: The horse show secretary can split the tack stalls and other charges, like feed and bedding, among clients of trainers. All splits must be in by Friday at 12pm. NO SPLITS WILL BE DONE ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY AT CHECK OUT.
- 17. Orders and Posted Orders of Go: All regular classes will have a "check-in" order of go that will be available beginning at 7am each day. All Classics will have a posted order of go. No changes to the order may be made, including swapping horses in the case of multiple rides, after the order is posted. Riders with multiple horses will be given at least 8 trips between rides if available.

18. Statement of Fees/Charges:

• Facility Fee: \$125. Applies to all horses showing or non-showing. These fees are non-refundable at any time, and allow horses unlimited add/scratches from classes (Exception: Classics

and Special Classes), access to schooling areas and lounging rings at designated times and covers use of medical personnel during show hours. This fee is assessed once, you may enter both the USEF show and the Outreach Show and you will be only charged ONEfacility.

- All horses showing or non showing will be charged Night Watch. Please fill out the night watching information on the "Barn Account Form" to ensure the safety of your horse.
- Organization Fees: These fees apply to all entries, with the exception of those entered only in the outreach competition. USEF Fee- \$8, USEF Drugs and Medication- \$15, USHJA Zone Fee- \$7. Non-member participants in the role of riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, lungers, owners, lessees, and agents must pay a Show Pass fee. Competitions cannot accept payment for a Show Pass from exhibitors. Show Pass purchases can only be made online on the USEF website by exhibitors. Non-member participants in the above roles are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year. To be eligible to participate at Federation Licensed Competitions, all persons acting as coaches or trainers, and legal guardians signing entry blanks as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors must be Senior Active Members in good standing. USHJA Outreach Fee: \$3- Applies to all horses showing in the USHJA Outreach portion of the horse show. If a horse cross-enters into the USEF show they will be subject to the USEF fees as they are mentioned above. Post Entry Fee- \$50: Applies to entries sent after December 20, except on-line entries defined in section 10.
- Stalls- Stalls should be ordered when submitting entries online. Please confirm total stall count via Stabling@HITSShows.com. Tent Stalls are approximately
- 10'x10' or 10'x12' (Premium), or 12' x 12' (Clear Span), under tents, with doors, dirt floors. Permanent Stalls are approximately 12'x12', with doors, dirt floors. Stall Fees are non-refundable after the Closing Date of Entries. Any stall order made by Entry, Fax, Email or other method will be considered an official stall order and exhibitors will be responsible for payment. Stalls are not transferable or sublettable except within the same trainer group. Stalls may be stripped or reconfigured at HITS discretion. Please contact our office with your plans and we will work with you to arrange the best options. Any showing horse, that has not purchased a stall from HITS will be assessed the Ship-in fee per week. Bedding on straw is prohibited except when the horse's health is at issue. Please obtain prior approval from Stable Office. Clean-up fee may apply. - Nomination Fee- \$200: Applies to horses competing in specific jumper classes or classics as specified in the class description section of this book. Fee is non-refundable after the start of the competition. Charged only once per horse regardless of the number of classes.
- RV SPACES: On-site RV spaces include water and 30 amp electric hook-up. On-site spaces are limited and preference will be given to Circuit RV reservations. Sewer and Gray Water/Pumpout is now included. Pumpouts will be done Wednesday, Friday, Sunday each week. RV spaces are non-refundable after the closing date of entries. RV spaces ordered after the closing date of entries will be accepted on a space available basis and may be subject to a Late RV Fee of \$50 additional per week. *Price includes 7% Sales Tax and 4% County Tourism Tax. Weekly RV - \$450
- SHIP-IN PARKING: A limited number of reserved ship-in parking spaces will be available. Please contact Matt@HITSShows.com for more information. Individual horses will still be required to pay the Ship-In Fee.RESERVED SHIP IN PARKING: \$200 (per trailer per week)
- SHIP-IN FEE: \$50 (per horse per week)
- Non-Showing Horse- \$50: Applies to horses entered in show but who has not shown in at least one class.
- Convenient Check-out- \$50: Applies to any horse show bill not closed out by the end of business each Sunday afternoon.
- Credit Card Surcharge: A 3% Surcharge will be added to all credit card payments.
- 19. Theft of Vendor Services/Products: Any persons found stealing from any of the vendors at the show, including but not limited to; screen shooting photographs/illegal duplication of photographs, theft of product/merchandise, and/or theft of services, may be subject to criminal prosecution. Their show bill will be charged and fined (Not less than \$250 per infraction) for the products or services that were taken or lost, and may be permanently barred from the competition grounds. Our vendors work just as hard as we do, don't steal from them!
- 20. Non-Negotiable Checks: Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 20% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order.
- 21. Protective Headgear: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. Reference USEF GR 801.2 & 4, HU 128, & EG 105.1.
- 22. Prize Money Caveat: Due to uncertainty: Classes with \$2,500 or more MAY, BUT NOT NECESSARILY, require 15 entries; if caveat is used, classes with less than 15 entries will be run as either a 100% sweep stake, or with reduced prize money and a reduced entry fee. Decision on whether to use this caveat will be made 12 hours prior to the start of any class offering \$2,500 or more in prize money, and due notice will be given to the exhibitors.
- 23. Equine Health Requirements: All owners should be able to provide, if asked, a Negative Coggins and Proof of Vaccinations within 6 months. All participants agree to fully cooperate with event officials and abide by their decisions and instructions. Failure to comply shall be grounds for immediate expulsion and potential disciplinary action by the event or by state/local or federal animal health officials.
- 24. Sharps and Medical Waste must be placed in the proper receptacles, located in the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management. ALL HORSES MUST BE CHECKED IN AND HAVE A NUMBER BEFORE ENTERING ANY BARN, STALL, OR SCHOOLING AREA. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 25. Measurement Requirements: All exhibitors in the Pony and Small Junior Hunter sections must produce a current measurement card BEFORE numbers will be released. Horses and ponies which do not possess a measurement card will be measured. A designated time and place will be announced. A copy of measurement card should be mailed in with entries if possible.
- 26. Amateur Requirement: All Amateur-Owner and Amateur riders will be required to provide the show office with their amateur certification BEFORE numbers will be released. A copy of amateur certification card should be mailed in with entries if possible.
- 27. Farrier/Veterinarian: The official show farrier and veterinarian will be on grounds during competition hours. Appointments will be made directly and accounts must be settled with respective parties at the show by Saturday at 5pm. Any out standing bill after that date may result in subsequent charges being applied to your show bill.
- 28. Foreign Exhibitors: The legend "US Fund" must be pre-printed on the face of all checks used to pay entry fees.
- 29. No Manual poling or the use off set oxers. Any rider, trainer, groom, or any other person who is in violation of this rule will be fined \$500 for each incident and WILL be removed from the show and reported by the USEF Steward to the Federation.
- **30.** Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts: USEF GR 1301.7: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- **31. 2025 COVID-19 Protocols:** All exhibitors, participants, and grooms are required to comply with the COVID-19 protocols as defined by the Horse Show and the USEF. All participants agree to any COVID restrictions, that may be over and above state and local government guidelines, imposed by the show, it's staff, or its vendors. Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks, cannot enter the competition grounds. Participants are required to self-monitor their temperature once daily prior to entering the competition grounds.
- 32. Safety & Welfare- The nearest Hospital & Trauma 1 Medical Centre to HITS Post Time Farm is Ocala Regional Medical Center 1431 SW 1st Ave, Ocala, FL 34471 352.401.1000. 17 miles, 25 minutes by car.
- **33. All Rated Division Horses will be jogged**: All horses will be jogged in the closing circle of the round.
- 34. Longeing: Horses must be longed in the official longeing area only. All horses must wear, or be accompanied with a visible entry number. No chasing, whip cracking, or plastic bags on whips. Stirrups may not hang from the saddle while longeing. Dangerous horses will not be permitted, and will be asked to leave. No phones or radios.
